- More often and severe
- Financial effects
- 1. Insurance fees will go up
- 2. Food prices will escalate

Heat Waves

- More frequent and extreme
- Monetary influences
- 1. Higher energy bills
- 2. Surge in medical expenditures

More Extreme Tropical Cyclones

- Higher wind speeds and rainfall totals
- Economic outcomes
- 1. Increase in government spending on disaster relief and aid
- 2. Surge in insurance rates

Glacier and Sea Ice Melting

- Sea level rise
- Financial impacts
- 1. Water bills will go up
- 2. Escalation in home prices

Extinctions and Declines in Wildlife Populations

- · Wildlife must adapt or perish
- Economic outcome
- 1. Elevated merchandise prices

Solutions

- Generate electricity using solar, wind or geothermal energy
- Use vehicles that run on electricity and other forms of alternative energy
- Remove greenhouse gas molecules from the atmosphere with machines
- Convert more areas into forest
