NWS Accomplishments



What has been done

Summary

National Weather Service (NWS) has made significant progress toward providing services to Spanish-speaking communities by delivering a number of NWS operational products and services in Spanish for many years. However, most of these efforts were being done by staff in the field whose main mission was to provide watches and warnings. Also, most of the work was being done manually therefore, the process is laborious and time-consuming.





NWS Accomplishments

The NWS provides services in languages other than English at a limited number of offices.

• Existing capabilities, which cover a limited number of languages, were created as local solutions. But these added significant workload for local staff performing translations.

2. Lluvias fuertes debido a Fiona se espera que continúen a través de Puerto Ricc hasta horas de la noche, desplazándose hacia la Republica Dominicana más tarde el día de hoy al lunes. Esta actividad de lluvia producirá inundaciones repentinas y urbanas amenazantes a la vida a través de Puerto Rico y sectores del este de la Republica Dominicana, junto con deslizamientos de tierra y de lodo en áreas de terreno empinados.

3. Se pronostica que Fiona se fortalezca justo luego de moverse fuera de Puerto Rico y la República Dominicana. Condiciones de tormenta tropical son posibles en las islas Turk y Caicos y el sureste de las Bahamas para tarde el lunes o temprano el martes.

NWS bilingual forecasters created two teams that translate active weather and preparedness information on a best-effort basis.

Probabilidades de Vientos de Tormenta Tropical



 Una probabilidad de 2 a 3 en 10 de vientos de tormenta tropical (35 a 45 mph), muy probablemente a través de las aguas de la parte baia del Valle y en las aguas del Golfo en el Extremo Sur de Texas y en la Laguna. I a hora más probable para los vientos es el sábado en la noche, pero podrían llegar tan pronto como el sábado por la tarde. La confianza es de baja a media en los cambios de intensidad, pero la cizalladura del viento linera debería mantener estas probabilidades bastante constantes El notencial de vientos con fuerza de tormenta tropical (ráfagas) en la parte superior del valle y Brush Country será determinado por cuánto tiempo puede permanecer intacto el sistema sobre tierra.



NWS Service Equity Priority Actions 2023-2026 Last Update: 17-Mar-2023

The NWS Assessment identified seven (7) barriers to achieving Equitable Services:



Most NWS operational services (forecasts and warnings) as well as education and outreach materials are conveyed exclusively in English. This leaves non-English and English as a Second language speakers unable or compromised in understanding and acting on the valuable weather information we provide.

Tools and Technology Actions

Language as barrier to achieve Equitable Services



- Develop a comprehensive plan to implement multilingual translation for NWS services for operational activities and for education and outreach.
- Prototype automated enterprise multilingual translation capability for NWS products and services.



Work in Progress



Develop a comprehensive plan to implement multilingual translation for NWS services

Focus on operational activities and on education and outreach

•To identify, document, evaluate, and develop options to streamline (if applicable) translations and services in Spanish and other languages already being done in the NWS; focusing primarily on those processes and actions that the NWS directly controls.

•Increase collaboration between all the Spanish/Language efforts across NWS, NOAA, DOC, and other government/NGO agencies regarding outreach, preparedness, and availability to the media.

•Increase the number of services and products being offered in languages other than English.
