

How Will Dual-Polarization Radar Benefit forecasters?

- 1. Identify non-weather targets more easily
- 2. Differentiate rain, snow, melting snow
- 3. Detect when hail is present in a thunderstorm
- 4. Improve detection of areas of heavy rain
- 5. Detect debris lofted by significant tornadoes
